The introduction of the new ZR-8630AV MultiZone Receiver, Solo IR and Select IR Master Keypads bring a new feature to the Niles Multi-Zone product line. The feature, known as "**Source-In-Use Indication**", alerts a user in any zone when they have selected a source component that is already in use by somebody else listening to the system. The second user will be alerted via a blinking yellow light on the master key of the source in use. When this occurs, any IR sequence that may be programmed for that source will not be issued upon the first press of that master key. This will ensure that the user who first accessed the source component will not experience any unwanted interruptions. A second press of that master key will issue the sequence.

Only the new Solo IR and Select IR Master Keypads support the new Source-In-Use Indication feature when combined with the ZR-8630AV. The basic versions of the Solo and Select Master Keypads without built-in IR sensors do not support the Source-In Use feature. Therefore, Source-In-Use Indication should be defeated when programming the ZR-8630AV for systems that include the basic Solo and Select Master Keypads or systems that include a combination of basic and IR capable keypads.

To defeat the Source-In-Use Indication feature:

1. Turn the ZR-8630AV ON
2. Press and hold the PROGRAM button for two seconds, until the LCD display shows "PGM MODE"
3. Press the Tuner Select button repeatedly until the LCD display shows "SrcU ON"
4. Press the Station Scan + button or Station Scan - button to toggle the setting to "SrcU OFF"
  - a. To turn it back ON, press the Station Scan + button or Station Scan - button again. The ZR-8630AV remembers the most recent setting
5. Press the PROGRAM button twice to exit programming
